CCC benefited from this venture by accumulating a much-needed inventory of cricket equipment from the overseas visitors.

Though CCC was unable to gain entry into the much-acclaimed Midwest Tournament in 1998 due to a delay in registration, it demonstrated the skill of its players by defeating the champions in a friendly game later that year.
